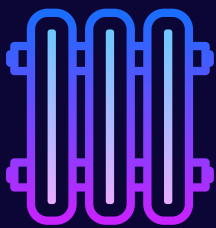


# BUILDINGS

Small changes can make a big difference, lets go through some simple checks and see what changes you can make...

## Do you have your time settings correct for when the building(s) are open?

Making sure that the times are set correctly, will prevent having your heating on when it isn't needed. Plan the most necessary times to have your heating on.



## Are there areas of your building(s) which aren't currently being used?

It's worth considering shutting any unused areas down, or applying reduced settings.

## Are temperature setpoints set up correctly?

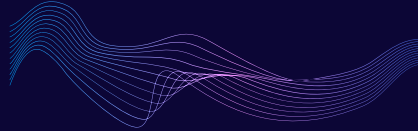
Reducing the setpoint by just 1°C will noticeably reduce your gas and electricity useage, without you feeling the difference.



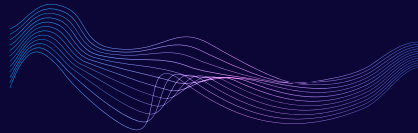
# CONTROL SYSTEM

Are you getting the most from your control system?

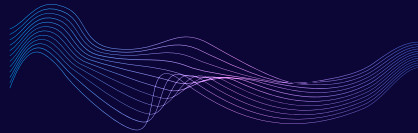
Can you remotely access your system to make changes or keep an eye on how your building(s) are functioning?
